Today in History



French queen Marie Antoinette was guillotined for treason in 1793. Initially charmed by her personality and beauty, the French people generally came to dislike her, accusing her of harboring sympathies for France's enemies, particularly Austria, her country of origin. She later became known as Madame Déficit because of her lavish spendings during famine times. The royal family was imprisoned at the Temple Prison. Marie Antoinette was herself tried and executed by guillotine.

Advisory groups: Meet with the same teacher as you do on Thursdays. This a time to get updated on current news at MSD and get support.

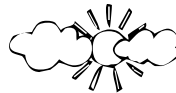
