Today in History



R. L. Stine was born in 1943. He is called the "Stephen King of children's literature," and is the author of hundreds of horror fiction novels. R. L. Stine's books have sold over 400 million copies as of 2008. The settings range from comfortable suburban areas to boarding schools, foreign villages to campsites. Books typically feature characters who either recently moved to a new neighborhood or are sent to stay with relatives. The Goosebumps series falls under the children's fiction, horror and thriller genres, although Stine characterizes the series as "scary books that are also funny."
